

First Step FAQ

How many hours do your school offer?

The required amount of hours to satisfy state requirements is 75, First Step has 76 scheduled hours.

High School or GED required? What age will you accept?

The state of Ohio does not require a candidate to have a High School Diploma, First Step will be accepting 17yr old high School or GED Students and over.

Also accepting anyone who may not have a High School Diploma or GED, but highest grade level was 11 grade.

How many students per class?

Per fire Marshall code, First Step Max Capacity is 20

What training will your students receive?

With over yrs 20 of nursing experience, first Step Students will receive practical skill training, continued development and mentoring as each student travel throughout their career, available 1 on 1 tutoring, from people who started out as STNA themselves.

What are other benefits of your program?

When will you begin and run your classes?

First Step STNA Program hopes to open its doors to student for its first class Oct 7, 2019 (Monday)
